Sign-In & Drop Off

Every staff member that works with children in any aspect at LSA is background checked in the highest form to be compliant with DCF guidelines. When students are dropped off your student does need to be signed in every day with a time, date, and signature from a parent/guardian. This is not an option, and must be someone listed on your students emergency contacts over 18 years of age

LSA T-shirts

T-Shirts can be purchase but is not mandatory, Adult sizes are \$12, and Youth sizes are \$10.

Behavior

Attitude and disruption of class/classes will result in being asked to leave the program. We are here to supply children in the community with quality classes, and a great summer experience. Unfortunately, we cannot take every child. We are not forcing any child to be here. We will not tolerate disrespect or attitude from any student. It is unfair to the children who want to be here and the ones waiting to be here. We will not waste time in making those tough decisions.

Bullying

Support

Lobby

Parents are not allowed to pass the lobby into rooms where classes are being held due to safety of all of our students. Dress Code

Each instructor may have their own specific dress code, however no student will be required to go out and purchase anything for classes, this is because not every family is able to purchase extra clothing so we will never require students to have to purchase anything for classes, and if this request is made, we need to know right away. Summer Camp- Flip flops may be wore, however we do ask your students always bring sneakers, and socks everyday. Summer Camp hours are long we want all students to be dressed accordingly, shorts can be wore but must can not be short-shorts, & No thin straps/spaghetti straps.

Personal Items-Unless student is bringing their own lunch we highly recommend students bring the last about of items as possible, it cuts down on space to store items, and we provide everything students need during the summer, any personal item, such as cell phones, or any electronics we are NOT responsible for, we have seen many broken over the years, and they are just safer at home.
